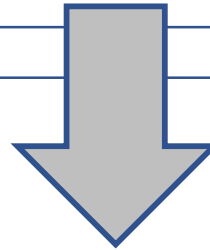


Writing an Artist Statement

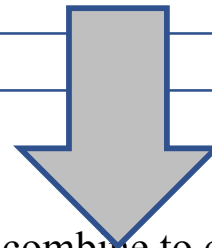
Step 1: Introduction and Inspiration

- What are we seeing? What does your piece look like?
- How did you pick the subject matter for this drawing? Why did you choose to draw what you did and not something else?



Step 2: Materials and Techniques

- What medium/media did you use?
- What techniques did you use to complete this drawing? (How did you apply the materials?) Did you use any special tools?
- Why did you choose this material/technique? How does it support what you are trying to communicate?
- What principles and elements of design are present?



Step 3: Intent & Resolution

- How do your inspirations and techniques combine to communicate your intention?
- What was your hope/goal/motivation for making this piece? Did you create it for a particular audience?
- Does your work touch on a social or political issue? Are emotions an important part of this work?
- Does this piece fit into a larger body of work?
