Art 8 is an introductory course that focuses on discovering the magic found in mixing the paints of the colour wheel, creating fun creative hand built clay projects, general design and drawing skills. Participation in Art 8 gives the student “a taste” of some of the basic skills of art and designs in order that they can continue to learn about and enjoy art in the future.

EVALUATION: Final mark includes process, progress, participation as well as the product made in each media area and sketchbook work.

SUPPLIES: In Art students will need a **sketchbook, pencil and eraser at every class**. Sketchbooks are 30% of the student’s grade. Sketchbooks can also take any form, such as blank or even a binder with white paper inside. Students will work on their sketchbooks on a daily basis. Sketchbook pages should be white. *Optional-* students can purchase sketchbooks or Art Kits from \$5-\$18 (see handout or class website for supplies details) from Ms. Trujillo.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

- **BE ON TIME-** When late wait by the door until invited in, 3 lates equals detention! If away, students must make up missed work.
- **FLEX TIME:** Students will have open studio time to work on projects and/or sketchbook.
