


## Design #1 - Op Art Waves




Draw vertical lines inside of your box. Use a ruler.




Draw a wave going across the top of the box.




Draw another wave going across the bottom of the box.



Begin coloring. Remember that black sections should never be adjacent to each other, and white sections should never be adjacent to each other.






#### Design #2 - Op Art Sunburst Letter




Draw a block letter inside the box.




Color every other space around the outside of the letter.




Draw a dot somewhere outside of the letter.



Cclor every other space on the actual letter itself. Remember that black sections should never be adjacent to each other and white sections should never be adjacent to each other.




Draw an even number of lines from the center of the dot to the edge of the box.




Keep coloring until you are finished.

## Design #3 - Op Art Tubes




Draw a line going from the upper left corner of your box to the lower right. Use a ruler.




Draw curved lines inside of each section as shown.


Alternate between drawing the curves outward and drawing the curves inward.




Draw another line from the upper right corner to the lower left.



Begin coloring.




Draw two more lines - one going from top to bottom and the other going straight across the middle of the box.






## Design #4 - Op Art Blobs




Draw four vertical wavy lines.







Draw curved lines in each section. Areas ABOVE the horizontal line should curve UPWARD.



Continue to draw curved lines. Areas BELOW the horizontal line should curve DOWNWARD.








#### Design #6 - Op Art Moving Targets




Divide the box into 16 sections.




Draw three more circles around each circle inside the box. Skip the lines when they run into the side of the box.




Draw a circle inside of each section. Change the position of the circle each time.



Begin coloring in the outer circles. Leave every other section white.




Color in every OTHER circle.




Keep coloring until you are finished.


## Design #7 - Bent Paper




Draw 3 lines going from the top of your box to the bottom. Vary the angle of each line.




Draw another set of parallel lines in both of the remaining sections. Make sure you change the angle of the lines as you move from one section to the other.




Draw a set of lines in the first section. The lines should be drawn ON AN ANGLE AND PARALLEL to each other.



Now color it! You can color in the lines going straight ACROSS the "bent paper" design pattern...




Now draw a set of parallel lires in the next section. They should meet up with the lines in the first section, but should be drawn on a different angle.




# Design #8 - Wavy Spectrum




Draw a straight line going from the upper left corner of your box to the lower right



Draw 4 more straight lines on either side of the original, starting in the top left corner of the box for each new line that you draw.




Starting along the LEFT SIDE of the box, draw two curved lines up towards the TOP of the box. The curves should be parallel to each other.



Starting at the BOTTOM of the box, draw two more curved parallel lines. This time they should END along the RIGHT SIDE of the box.






## Design #9 - Floating Circles




Draw a bunch of straight, parallel lines inside of the box. Use a ruler.






Draw a circle inside of the box.



Keep coloring.






## Design #10 - Floating Globe




Draw a large circle with a "+" sign in it.




Draw two curved lines ABOVE the horizontal line. The lines should curve outward towards the TOP curve of the circle.




Draw two curved lines to the LEFT of the vertical line. The lines should curve outward towards the LEFT curve of the circle.



Draw two curved lines BELOW the horizontal line. The lines should curve outward towards the BOTTOM curve of the circle.



Draw two curved lines to the RIGHT of the vertical line. The lines should curve outward towards the RIGHT curve of the circle.



Add a checkerboard background and begin coloring. Remember that black sections should never be adjacent to each other, and white sections should never be adjacent to each other.
