

ART-I-FACT- Use “Art” to make up some “Facts” about an Artifact

ar-ti-fact ('ärdəfakt) *NOUN* - an object made by a human being, typically an item of cultural or historical interest.

gadg-et ('gajət) *NOUN* - a small mechanical or electronic device or tool, especially an ingenious or novel one

1. While you walk through the museum, open drawers and look at a variety of items until you find something you find interesting. Take a photo of the artifact and note whatever info you can find about it at the museum.
2. In class, email me you photo, I will print it out for you
3. Now it is time to be crazy creative. Use your IMAGINATION to make up what this object is or was used for. You can base this on the cultural origin of this object or it can be 100% made up. Have fun with this...be ridiculous. Stretch your imagination.
4. Come up with a catchy name for your artifact...we will now refer to it a as gadget. Think of its purpose and who would use it (your audience)
5. Research magazine full page advertisements- what common element stand out? (ie Bold colors)
