
Pictographs- First Nations symbols that tell a story




Pictographs formed the basis for early written symbols as used by ancient Egyptian, Sumerian and Chinese civilizations. These ancient civilizations used symbols nearly 5000 years back and developed them into writing systems during the third millennium BCE. Interestingly, pictographs continue to be used as a symbol of writing in certain backward cultures of Africa, Oceania and the Americas.

The modern written language has in a way emerged after the use of pictographs. The modern artist Xu Bing developed a universal language, consisting of pictograms used all over the world, called the "Book from the Ground"

Pictographs are commonly used today as pictorial signs, statistical diagrams or instructions in various fields. Pictographs are graphic in nature and are used to indicate places such as train stations, airports, hotels, public toilets and so on. Similarly a universal set of pictographs is used as laundry symbols on clothing labels.

- 1. Pick a story from the list http://haidalegends.blogspot.ca/2011/09/qing.html and tell the story using symbols that you create. For example walking might look like this.
- 2. You have to use at least 10 symbols...write the story in such a way that you can use the symbols retell the story
- 3. Look at the labelled BC pictographs, identify which symbols are similar
- 4. Compare 8 pictographs from another culture (Shawnee, Egyptian, Chinese, African, ...you choose)
- 5. Write a short hero story, with a beginning, a setting, an event and a return to normal
- 6. Select pictographs from a culture of your choice and write a pictograph version of your story. You can write it from right to left like we typically write or in a spiral with the ending at the big end of the spiral or at the center.




- 7. Title page: choose a rock print out page (from pile provided) recreate it using watercolor pastels, salt, alcohol, medium) and draw a
